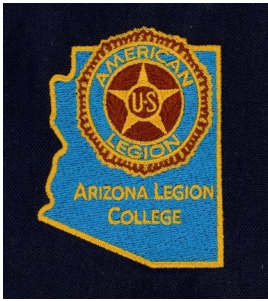

The Arizona Legion College will prepare Students for leadership positions through education, development, and motivation. The curriculum challenges student leaders to think critically and creatively about issues confronting the American Legion Family.

The curriculum centers on instruction by graduate facilitators, Department and National officers. Students review The American Legion's core values, develop new ideas and consider the future. The emphasis of the curriculum is on programs, management techniques and leadership skills necessary to increase the visibility of programs, growth in membership, and public awareness of the Legion and its post organizations.

Throughout the course, students will learn the basics of developing communication strategies to promote American Legion Family programs, combined with the breakouts and hands-on exercises. Topics include public outreach, media relations, membership recruitment and retention, mylegion.org, Post/Unit/Squadron revitalization and community relations.
